# 8TH ANNUAL NEW MEXICO OPEN

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. This is a scratch tournament open to all bowlers, male and female, including youth, 16 years and older, who are current members of USBC. Entry includes all members of all professional bowling organizations. Bowlers may purchase USBC membership at the host Center. Youth bowlers, 16 years and older as of the date of qualifying, must sign a USBC Prize Waiver Form prior to the start of competition and designate to take their prize in the form of a youth scholarship.
2. The tournament will be certified and conducted in accordance with the general playing rules and regulations of the USBC. Certification #04006.
3. Qualifying squad times will be available after 6:00 pm on Wednesday, August 17. Entries will, however, be accepted until 6:00 pm on Saturday, August 20, provided lanes are available. Re-entries are not allowed.
4. As bowlers arrive at Tenpins & More, they will be required to check-in and pay any outstanding fees. Qualifying squads will commence as scheduled; any bowler not present will forfeit missed frames, unless a prior squad change has been arranged and confirmed by the tournament director.
5. The 48 semi-finalists will be decided over 9 games bowled across 18 lanes.
6. The 12 finalists will be decided over a further 4 games, bowled across 8 lanes. Pinfall will be carried over from the earlier round.
7. Pinfall is carried over from previous 13 games. The 12 finalists will compete over one round of matchplay, including a 12th game positional round, adding 30 bonus pins for each game won and 15 bonus pins each for tied matches.
8. At this stage, the top 5 will contest the step-ladder finals - 5th v 4th, winner v 3rd, winner v 2nd, winner v 1st. All matches will be over one game with ties decided by a 9th/10th frame roll-off until broken.
9. Should a tie occur for 48th place, 12th place, or any of the top 5 placings prior to the step-ladder finals, a one game roll-off and, if necessary, a 9th/10th frame roll-off will be bowled until the tie is broken. Ties for positions 6th to 12th after matchplay or 13th to 72nd after qualifying will split the prizemoney. It is the bowler's sole responsibility to determine if they are required for any tie-breakers.
10. A substitute will be permitted in the matchplay segment. A bowler who has satisfied the tournament director they are unable to continue may be replaced by the first available reserve. A substitute may not appear in the step-ladder finals. Their place would be taken by a bowler, next in line, who had completed all 12 games that day. A bowler may not return after being replaced.
11. Any protests affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director before the tournament prize payments are made. The decision of the tournament director will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
12. The top 5 bowlers must wear shirts provided by the tournament director. Personal sponsors logo patches may be displayed on this shirt.
13. All prizemoney and awards are subject to a field of 192 bowlers entering and will be adjusted according to the number of bowlers. The prize fund portion of each bowler's entry fee is \$125, which will be returned 100% to the prizewinners, while lineage and expense fees are \$75.  
USBC Rule 308 has been followed. (The New Mexico Open prize fund portion of bowler's entry fees of \$24,000 is easily covered in the total proposed pay-out of more than \$40,575.)
