Tournament Rules and Format

1. All entries must be postmarked by deadline entry date on front of this form.
2. This tournament is open to all CNM USBC Youth certified bowlers bowling in one of CNM USBC Association Youth Leagues or local High Schools. If this your first year to bowl, then indicate this on form with a "Y" in 1st yr column.
3. There will be Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events in three classes as outlined below. The Team will be limited to four (4) members. Each entrant may enter the Team event as many times as squad scheduling permits, provided no more than two bowlers enter on the same team. Bowlers may enter Doubles & Singles as many times as squad schedule permits, but may not enter with the same Doubles partner more than once. You may only win one singles award. If the entrant enters in the Doubles & Singles event, the entrant must participate in both events. Bowlers will bowl in the order as entered on the entry form. Bowler 1A bowls with bowler 1B and 2A with 2B for Doubles. Substitutes will be permitted only in the same lineup position as the bowler he or she replaces. Each event will consist of the three games and the Singles event will be bowled first in the Doubles & Singles competition. The scores bowled in the first Team, Doubles & Singles event entered will be scores used for determining the All Events total. All bowlers shall **check in thirty (30) minutes prior to the assigned squad time.**
4. Verification of average (dated league standing sheet) is required. Average precedence: a) Entrants must use their highest average based on fifteen (15) games or more (includes all league sessions bowled up to and including **December 25, 2011**). b) If entrant has not established 15 games in CNM-USBC as of that date, then league official will submit document that reflects their average as of their completed 15th game. c) If entrant does not have 15 games in by the day of competition they may use the previous season's winter CNM USBC Youth book average to this date. d) If none then entrants may use the previous season's CNM USBC Youth summer book average. e) If none, then entrant must bowl scratch. The handicap for all classes will be 90% of the difference between bowler's average and 200. Rule 319e applies (Last 12 month tournament avg. of certified and/or uncertified for 15 games or more exceeds this average by 15 pins). Rule 319d does not apply. Sport league averages will be adjusted in accordance with current USBC Playbook. Specify on the entry form if the average provided is an unconverted sport average by placing the letter "s" behind it. If you converted, place the letter "c" behind it. The falsification of average may result in automatic disqualification of bowler and forfeiture of all awards in any event bowled.
5. Scholarship money and certificates are awarded to winners in each class for the Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events based on a prize ratio of at least one award for each four entries. Scholarship money and certificates will be awarded to handicap winners in each event for each class for male and female. Although this is a handicap tournament, scratch chevrons will be provided for Singles and All events winners. Scholarship monies come from entry fees after costs, tournament committee held activities (50/50's during each squad time, etc), possible donations, and unused expense fees. SMART account # 9156.
6. Entry form is to be signed by the League Official or Supervisor (Reference USBC rule book for definition of position). The league official will furnish the correct league standing sheets in accordance with rule 4 to the Tournament Director listed on back of this form by the deadline date. Entrants must use name as it appears on their CNM USBC Youth Certification Card.
7. Entries will not be accepted without the total entry fee included and full entry form properly filled out. No refunds will be made after the entry has been processed and the squad times are set. Individuals with a returned check will pay cash to the association in the amount of the original check amount and a \$25 service charge. No post-dated checks will be accepted.
8. Averages will be used in each division as follows:

9. **Junior Gold Event Qualifier** – You must be a Junior Gold Program Member and must pay an additional entry fee of \$25.00 prior to the start of your first qualifying event. Central New Mexico USBC has reserved two qualifier spots. JG scores are based on your Double-Singles scratch scores (6 games). If there are not enough girls (at least 4) entered to host a girl's qualifier by the start of the event then there will an Open (boy and girl mixed) qualifier only and the top two six game scratch total scores will be seeded to the National Junior Gold Tournament.
10. Whenever possible, events will be scheduled according to the entry date and time assigned by the Tournament Director listed below based on his/her receipt of entries. The Tournament Director reserves the right to reschedule any event as necessary. League Officials will be informed about the times and dates of each entry. Each League Official should make copies of each entry signed, for their own records.
11. Any appeals or protests concerning scores or eligibility must be submitted to the Tournament Director in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after the alleged infraction occurred.
12. This tournament will be governed by the rules and regulations set by the USBC. USBC Youth eligibility rules will be enforced. **ALL DECISIONS MADE BY TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR ARE FINAL.**
13. USBC Youth codes of conduct will be followed for this tournament. **Clothes with obscene language/gestures, revealing clothes, headgear (cap, hat, bandana, beanie, etc) will not be allowed. Collared or turtle-neck mock shirts, or USBC provided Youth Jersey must be worn for all events.** Please also note that this will be a smoke and alcohol free environment within the designated area of the bowling center during tournament competition. There will be **NO electronic devices** (video games, radios, CD players, cell phones, etc) used by bowlers during the bowling event. Spectators with phones must set to vibrate or turn off. When on the approach a bowler shall be wearing authorized bowling shoes.
